## What is it? Why do it?

- Temporary reconfiguration of an existing roadway
- To promote safe walking and cycling
- To educate the public on alternative street designs
- To educate and explore options for future roadway projects
- To engage the public on complete street concepts and policies
- Many cities and towns are doing or have done these projects
  - Portsmouth
  - Keene
  - Burlington



## The idea

- Broadway from Pillsbury to Rollins Park
- First week in August.
  - Setup Friday July 28th
  - Tear Down Friday August 4th
  - National Night Out, Tuesday August 1<sup>st</sup>
- No parking on west side of Broadway (even numbered side)
- Starting from the west side and moving east
  - Protected Bike lane
  - Barrier
  - Motor vehicle lane (Southbound)
  - Motor vehicle lane (northbound)
  - Parking
  - Separated bike lane
